Admission Requirements

Year 1 Entry: Level 3 in English Language and Chinese Language; and Level 2 in Mathematics (Compulsory Part) and Liberal Studies; and Level 2 in Elective/Applied Learning Subject (3322+2); OR obtain equivalent qualifications.

Year 3 Entry: Student must have completed a recognised HKQF Level 4 programme in a related discipline. Applicants from unrelated disciplines who have demonstrated foundation knowledge in aviation may also be considered (took one year of aviation-related courses offered by UOWCHK.)

Duration: 4 years or 2 years (senior year entry)
Credit Points: 120 (4 years) or 60 (2 years)
